Celebrating her 50<sup>th</sup> Golden Jubilee of being a Sister Servant of Mary Immaculate this year, Sr. Carol, in a much shorter version of her religious life history, noted that when she came to work at St. Joseph's in 1967 as a Registered Dietitian, she saw and was "conquered" by the great work being done by the Sisters as well as the kind, personal atmosphere extended to residents, staff, family members and visitors alike.
